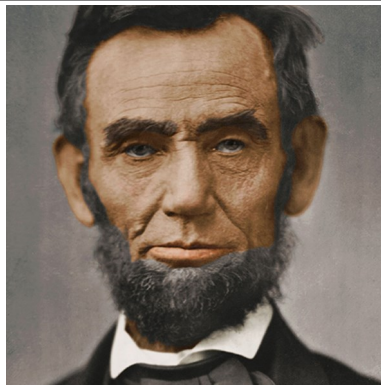

Do you think you know everything there is to know about Abraham Lincoln? Learn more by attending this one-hour program based on Tom Emery's book by the same name. He will discuss some of the lesser-known experiences of the 16th president with fresh looks on the more famous episodes. Emery will cover Lincoln's presidential life, including his early romances, his work as a surveyor and postmaster, first political campaigns and some of his notable friendships.
