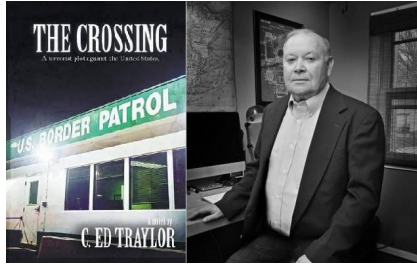

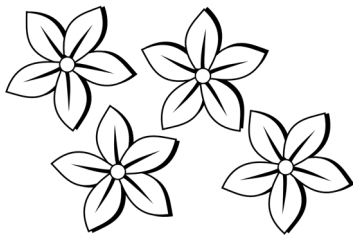

The Community Book Club will meet to discuss *The*

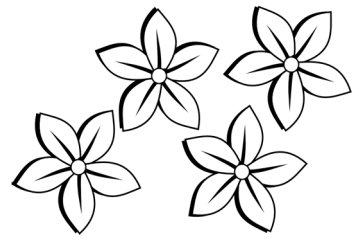
Master and His Emissary by Iain McGilchrist. This is the last Book Club meeting until August.

Book Club selections may be checked out from the library or purchased from Our Town Books on the square.





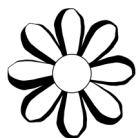
