at 10am**



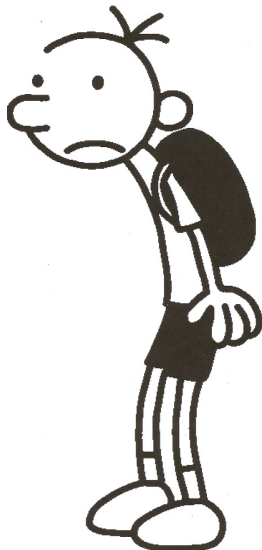

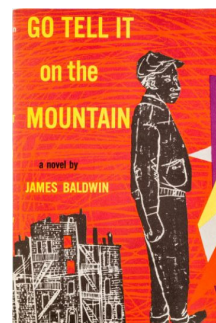


**Check the newsletter each month for new staff recommendations!**
