

To Help Prevent the Spread of the COVID-19 Virus, the Jacksonville Public Library Has Implemented the Following Temporary Guidelines

- A mask or face covering is required to be worn while inside the library building.
- Please attempt to maintain 6 feet social distancing from others.
- Maximum occupancy is 78 patrons at one time.
- A limited number of public computers will be available for public use to ensure proper social distancing.
- The children's play area will be closed and toys will not be offered.
- The meeting room may be scheduled for groups of 16 or fewer, and the conference room may be scheduled for groups of 4 or fewer, with masks and 6 feet social distancing required. These capacity limits are to help ensure social distancing. The same guidelines apply to library meetings and programs held in the conference room or meeting room.
- Library staff will practice proper hygiene techniques, including frequent hand washing.
- Frequently touched surfaces, such as desktops, railings and computers will be disinfected regularly.
- In order to ensure social distancing, most chairs will be removed.
- All returned library materials will be quarantined for 24 hours before being placed back into circulation.
